## Couple wins five-night cruise for two in Fred. Olsen Cruise Lines' short story writing competition

Jennie and her partner Dan will join *Balmoral's* five-night L2112 'Springtime Fjords in Five Nights' cruise from Newcastle on 1<sup>st</sup> May 2021. It will be a double celebration for the couple, who will also be able to mark Jennie's birthday on board on 4<sup>th</sup> May.

On winning the competition, Jennie said: "I was absolutely overwhelmed – I never expected to win!

"Cruising is my favourite type of holiday, and the Norwegian fjords have always been on my bucket list. The chance that I might win and have the opportunity to do this on a Fred. Olsen cruise seemed an opportunity too great to miss, so I thought 'what if?' and went for it.

"The inspiration for this story really came from past cruising holidays. We

often sit in our robes at the beginning and end of the day and they are some of my favourite memories. I was really inspired by the love we have for exploring new places and how precious those sorts of memories are.”
