## **‘Experiential’ cruises come out on top in Fred. Olsen Cruise Lines’ ten best-sellers list**

Fred. Olsen Cruise Lines has released its latest ‘Top 10’ best-selling cruises for the rest of the 2014/15 cruise season. Fred. Olsen’s four more traditional, intimate ships – *Balmoral*, *Braemar*, *Boudicca* and *Black Watch* – visit over 200 destinations around the world, from ten convenient, regional UK departures ports – Southampton, Dover, Harwich, Tilbury, Bristol (Avonmouth), Liverpool, Newcastle, Rosyth (for Edinburgh), Greenock (for Glasgow) and Belfast.

Fred. Olsen’s current ‘Top 10’ best-selling cruises are as follows:

**1) *Boudicca's* two-night D1425 'Festive Dublin Mini-Cruise', ex Liverpool on 10<sup>th</sup> December 2014.** Prices start from £129 per person.

**2) *Balmoral's* 119-night L1501 'Far East Explorer' cruise, ex Southampton on 4<sup>th</sup> January 2015.** Prices start from £8,999 per person.

This incredible 'Grand Voyage' is Fred. Olsen's longest-ever sailing and is the ultimate 'holiday of a lifetime'. **4) *Balmoral's* 19-night L150134 'From Bustling Bombay to Beautiful Burma' fly-cruise, ex Dubai on 27<sup>th</sup> January 2015.** Prices start from £2,513 per person, including return flights and transfers.

Departing from the modern metropolis of Dubai, *Balmoral* then cruises to India – with a stop in Mumbai, where guests can take an overland tour to the legendary Taj Mahal memorial – and Sri Lanka. Next is an overnight stay in Yangon in Myanmar (formerly Burma), before arriving in Kuala Lumpur (Malaysia).

**5) *Boudicca's* 14-night D1506 'African Escapade & Easter Parade' cruise, ex Southampton on 24<sup>th</sup> March 2015.** Prices start from £1,079 per person.

On this Spring sunshine cruise, *Boudicca* takes in Casablanca (Morocco), Algiers (Algeria) and Melilla (Spanish Morocco) in Northern Africa, as well as Gibraltar, Lisbon in Portugal and two beautiful stops in Spain – Cartagena and Malaga. With a late-night stay in Malaga, guests can enjoy the spectacular ‘Maundy Thursday’ procession.

**6) *Balmoral’s* eight-night L1502 ‘Scenic Railway & Phenomenal Fjords’ cruise, ex Southampton on 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2015.** Prices start from £799 per person.

*Balmoral* will cruise to the picturesque Norwegian towns of Stavanger, Olden and Flåm – where guests can take a trip on the famous Flåmsbana Railway, to enjoy the fantastic views. Guests will also be able to enjoy a scenic cruise past Hardangerfjord and Nærøfjord – which has been rated as the world's number one natural heritage site by National Geographic.

**7) *Boudicca’s* seven-night D1514 ‘Highlights of the Highlands’ cruise, ex Rosyth (Edinburgh) on 21<sup>st</sup> June 2015.** Prices start from £799 per person.

From the grandeur of the Orkney Isles to the beauty of the Shetlands, guests on board *Boudicca* for this ‘Around the UK’ cruise will be able to explore some of the most remote and attractive islands off the coast of Britain.

**8) *Black Watch’s* 11-night W1511 ‘Icelandic Wildlife & Waterfalls’ cruise, ex Liverpool on 12<sup>th</sup> July 2015.** Prices start from £1,199 per person.

Guests will have a chance to discover the naturally impressive Iceland – ‘the land of fire and ice’ – on this unique cruise. With an abundance of wildlife and dramatic landscapes, including geysers, waterfalls and volcanos, this extraordinary destination is sure to ‘wow’ guests. **9) *Braemar’s* 14-night M1521 ‘Falls, Fjords & Faroe Islands’ cruise, ex Dover on 18<sup>th</sup> July 2015.** Prices start from £1,499 per person.

*Braemar* will call at the remote Faroe Islands, before visiting three destinations in Iceland, including the capital city Reykjavik. Arriving in Bergen, Norway’s second city, guests will be part of a very exciting celebration for Fred. Olsen, as all four ships across the fleet dock in the

Norwegian city together for the first time ever.

**10) Balmoral's 13-night L1513 'Meteor Showers & Sunbathing' cruise, ex Southampton on 8<sup>th</sup> August 2015.** Prices start from £1,299 per person.

This 'experiential' cruise will give guests the opportunity to view the stunning, multi-coloured 'Perseid Meteor Shower' at the optimum time, whilst visiting the beautiful Canary Islands and Portugal.

All prices are based on two adults sharing a twin-bedded, Inside cabin, and include accommodation, all meals and entertainment on board, plus port / airport dues and transfers, where applicable.
