Agents were also treated to a wine-tasting experience, before cruising on *Boudicca* to Port Elizabeth for another highlight of the trip – a game drive, where they got to see an incredible array of wildlife, including a rare White Lion!

Whilst on board *Boudicca*, the Viking Masters enjoyed all-Suite accommodation and dined at Fred. Olsen's new alfresco Grill Restaurant. The Fred.
