First call will be Gibraltar, with its world-famous Rock, followed by Valletta, the multi-cultural capital of Malta, and the Turkish city of Istanbul, at the 'Crossroads of Europe and Asia', before a scenic cruise along the narrow Bosphorus Strait, leading to the Black Sea.

Visit the rolling wine vineyards of Georgia, explore the labyrinthine corridors of one of the world's largest historic Catacombs, taste fresh tea on one of Sochi's many plantations, and take in the stunning views on a boat tour along the Danube.

The price shown is based on two adults sharing a twin-bedded Interior Room, and include accommodation, all meals and entertainment, plus port taxes.

Fred. Olsen's new D2023 'Black Sea Discovery with the Med' sailing is the third itinerary to be released in advance from its 2020/21 cruise programme,

following on from the launch of its <u>L2026 'American Waterways in the Fall</u> with New York' sailing, aboard its flagship *Balmoral*, and the <u>M2109 'Greek Islands and Corinth Canal'</u> cruise, aboard shallow-drafted *Braemar*.
