## Fred. Olsen celebrates successful second 'Brabant' river cruise season with great-value 'Tours, Dining Drinks & Tips' offer in 2020

Notably, every Fred. Olsen river cruise will incorporate plenty of daytime scenic cruising, so that guests can enjoy some of Europe's most fantastic scenery – with 14 areas of scheduled scenic cruising included across the itineraries.

Experience time-honoured traditions and treasures, such as Serbian music and dancing, and taste authentic Hungarian Paprika.

- Seven-night R2019 'Sailing the scenic Moselle to Luxembourg' fly-cruise (flights from London / Manchester), ex Cologne, Germany on  $30^{th}$  August 2020. Prices start from £1,699 per person.

This route, sailing all the way down to Luxembourg, is one rarely taken by river ships. Spend time in Remich – the 'Pearl of the Moselle' – and marvel at the twin-spired Gothic cathedral and Ehrenbreitstein Fortress in Cologne, accompanied by Professor Andrew Hopkins, internationally recognised for his architectural knowledge.
