Fred. Olsen Cruise Lines' 1,350-guest flagship, *Balmoral*, made her maiden call into Darwin, Australia, on 8<sup>th</sup> March 2013, as part of her longest-ever 'World Cruise', of 112 nights. This symbolic event was celebrated with a plaque exchange between Fred. Olsen and Darwin Port Corporation in the ship's 'Morning Light Pub', named after Fred. Olsen's first ever ship from the company's inception in 1848.
