This superb cruise visits not only Helsinki, Copenhagen and medieval Visby, but also docks overnight in St. Petersburg, the 'Gem of Russia', and sails along the Kiel Canal.

4) Black Watch's 16-night W1514 'Rugged & Rural Canada' cruise, ex Liverpool on 14<sup>th</sup> August 2015. Prices start from £2,159 per person.
