## Fred. Olsen Raises Funds for Haiti

Following the disastrous earthquake that afflicted Haiti in January this year, passengers on the Fred. Olsen cruise ships expressed their desire to help and a fund was quickly established on board each ship. A combination of contributions from passengers and Fred. Earthquakes are devastating, whichever country they affect, but it is always the poorest countries that seem to suffer the most, and Haiti is one of the poorest nations on earth. We know our donation will be used most effectively by the DEC and wish them every success with their fundraising."
