Beatles fans will also get the opportunity to experience one of the most authentic tribute acts on the circuit, when the **Upbeat Beatles** take to the stage on this Caribbean cruise. An added attraction on this cruise is Fred. Olsen's programme of special

interests – **The ArtsClub** – which invites specialists in different fields to come on board and give talks and tuition in their specialist subject.
