Watch F1 World Champion Lewis Hamilton defend his title at the 2016 Monaco Grand Prix with Fred. Olsen

On Fred. Fred. Olsen is offering guests a choice of two special tours packages for the Monaco Grand Prix, each offering a spectacular view of the big race:

Grandstand K stretches from Tabac to the Swimming Pool section, and tickets for the Upper section guarantee a great view of this part of the circuit, as well as a view up to the Tunnel Exit. This is a great spot to see the impressive performance of the F1 cars as they corner at high speed between the unforgiving barriers.

Grandstand T is located in Monaco Harbour. With a large seating capacity, it enjoys a view of the straight section that follows the Swimming Pool Complex. Its location in front of the pits places guests at a key part of the track, and the big screen opposite follows the action on other parts of the circuit.

Prices for this ‘Cruise & Grand Prix’ package start from **£2,588** per person, and include:

- En-suite accommodation in an ‘Ocean View Cabin’, all meals, tea and coffee, evening entertainment, daytime activities and on board leisure facilities
- Return coach transfers from Nice to Monaco

The first stop on this exhilarating cruise holiday is to **Gibraltar**, where guests can take a trip to see the famous Barbary apes, indulge in some duty-free shopping or board a cable car to enjoy the impressive views of nearby Spain and Africa.

Black Watch then sets sail for architectural masterpiece, **Barcelona** (Spain). Here, guests can take in some of Gaudi's finest work, including the Sagrada Familia Cathedral, still a work in progress.

Next, is glamorous **Cannes** (France); this picturesque city, located on the French Riviera, is home to beautiful beaches, luxury casinos, fascinating museums and glorious sunshine most of the year round. While in **Alicante** (Spain), guests can enjoy a leisurely walk along the wide esplanades to soak up the Mediterranean sun, or take a shore excursion to visit Huerto De Cura Botanical Gardens and the city of Murcia.

Black Watch will then make its final call in **Malaga**, the birthplace of Picasso. Be sure to take a stroll around the grand Alhambra Palace in Granada, or head for the countryside of Andalucía to discover the fruits and flavours of the 'Sunshine Valley'.

Price includes accommodation, all meals and entertainment on board, port taxes and Monaco Grand Prix shore tour – Grandstand K or T. Guests can also choose to upgrade to the 'all-inclusive' drinks package for just £10 per person, per night.
